## Around the Club House

To update you on some of the other business around the club house:

### Carpet Tiles

Some (or all) of you may have noticed that we have had a problem with the carpet tiles not adhering well to the floor.

We have spoken to both the manufacturer as well as the company that sold/installed them and are planning to utilize some warranty offerings to repair them as necessary.

However, since it is believed that some of the problem with the current

tiles is that it was not warm enough when they were installed, we are planning to wait until this spring to proceed.

### Outside target area

We are also slated to work on enlarging the concrete pad and covering the outside target(s) this spring.

### Baby Changing Table

### Ground Sterilizer

The Board has also approved the purchase and application of a ground sterilizer. This is a 5-year product that will prevent the growth of weeds on our property.
